



Author Guidelines

Preparation of your paper

All manuscripts, either for Regular Sessions or for Special Sessions, should follow the recommended IEEE conference author guidelines. MS Word and LaTeX templates, as well as support, can be found at the following websites:

The acceptance paper page limit is 6-8 pages for the first submission. For the final submission, however, the paper page limit is 6 pages with the option of 2 additional pages with an extra charge. The IEEE template applies to either of the two manuscript submission types. All manuscripts submitted to IEEE ITSC 2020 must be written in English and formatted in the standard IEEE 2-column A4 format. Both, the Initial submission and Final submission must use the A4 paper format only. Please notice that **abstracts should not exceed the limit of 200 words**.

All submitted papers will be peer-reviewed, and accepted papers will be published by the IEEE and included in IEEE Xplore.

Paper Submission

Regular Session Manuscripts as well as Special Session Manuscripts should be submitted via PaperPlaza (<http://its.papercept.net/conferences/scripts/start.pl>). When you access the PaperPlaza, choose the **"Submit a contribution to ITSC 2020"**.

It is important that you prepare the following information before making any attempt to submit your manuscript.

- **Title of the manuscript.**
- **Short abstract** (200 words as stated above).
- **PINs of "ALL" co-authors** (you can locate your co-authors' PIN by following PIN link from its.papercept.net)
- **Authors names and affiliations** (the review process is not double blinded).
- **Keywords:** you will be prompted for 1-3 conference specific keywords during the initial submission process.
- **Manuscript file:** this should be one of the following
 - A PDF file (version 1.4 or higher), have all fonts embedded/subsetted, in A4 page size, searchable, non-password protected document. You can validate your PDF file by clicking on this [link](#).
 - A single Word file based on the template.
 - A singled zipped file containing all LaTeX sources, images, style/cls files including the ieeeconf.cls, bib files, with the main tex file called root.tex (documentclass must be a4paper).

You will have a chance to update all this information at the time of final submission.
